

Job Description: Lead Production Manager (De-Rig)

The Role

The Lead Production Manager (De-Rig) will lead the planning for, coordination and actualisation of a safe, efficient and timely dismantling and handover of STOREHOUSE, a large scale (containing an intricate set, within 9000 square meter space) immersive theatre production in Deptford, London.

This freelance role runs from early September to 24 October 2025. Initially a combination of office and site base, full time on-site work begins 20 September. The role focuses on overseeing the de-rigging of all scenic, technical and operational elements, ensuring the venue is returned to its agreed condition, and all associated teams are impeccably managed and supported.

The ideal candidate will have substantial experience managing large-scale builds, de-rigs or strikes in theatre, live events or immersive environments, excellent leadership and organisational skills and a deep understanding of health and safety best practices.

Key Responsibilities

De-Rig Management

- **Planning and Scheduling:** Oversee and implement a detailed de-rig schedule aligned with project deadlines. Coordinate with internal departments, contractors and suppliers to ensure smooth workflow and timely completion.
- Crew and Contractor Supervision: Lead and supervise onsite teams, crews and contractors, providing clear direction and maintaining safe standards of work. Act as the primary point of contact between production, venue and external teams throughout the de-rig period.
- **Venue Handover:** Oversee the removal, storage or disposal of all scenic, technical and operational elements. Ensure the site is cleaned and restored to the agreed condition in accordance with contractual and regulatory requirements.



Operational Oversight

- Health and Safety Compliance: Working with our health and safety consultants; ensure all activities are conducted in line with UK health and safety legislation, risk assessments and site protocols. Identify and mitigate any hazards, ensuring a safe working environment for all personnel.
- **Budget and Resource Management:** Monitor and manage the de-rig budget, approving costs within agreed limits and maintaining accurate records. Working with the production team to allocate resources effectively to meet project goals and deadlines.
- **Documentation and Reporting:** Maintain clear, up-to-date documentation, including de-rig schedules, inventories and handover reports. Provide regular updates to the Lead Producer on progress and any issues arising.
- **Problem Solving:** Troubleshoot operational challenges quickly and effectively, maintaining a calm and solutions-focused approach under pressure.

Key Deliverables

Working to and adapting a comprehensive and achievable de-rig schedule. A fully de-rigged and restored venue by 17 October 2025. Accurate documentation of de-rig activities, including inventories and handover reports. Safe and compliant de-rig operations throughout the contract period.

Qualifications and Skills

Experience

At least 5 years' experience as a Head of Production / Senior Production Manager or similar senior role in live events, theatre or immersive experiences. Proven track record of managing complex de-rigs or strikes on large-scale productions, including location based.

Skills

Strong leadership and team management abilities. Excellent organisational and scheduling skills. Clear, confident communication and negotiation skills. Proficiency with production management tools and documentation. Thorough knowledge of UK health and safety regulations, including CDM where applicable.
